The material in our archive is organised by type (see Index) and includes photographs, artefacts, property details and newspaper cuttings, amongst other things.

You can search the catalogue document using the Search or Find functions on your computer. If you are interested in a particular house, for example, you could search on the number and road e.g. 192 Tadcaster Road, to find all entries in all categories. If your interest is broader e.g. in the old shops, using the term 'shop' will ensure that you find pictures, newspaper cuttings, books etc that mention any shops.

Please note that individual items in different categories may have the same item number – for example, there is an M1 in photographs, newspaper cuttings and property details.

So when you have identified material that you would like to see, please ensure that you ask for it **by type and number** when you contact us e.g.

'Photograph M1 and Newspaper cutting D11'. If you just ask for M1 and D11, we won't know which items you require.
